
Sir,

I would like to inform you that under the Youth Exchange Programme of this Department, youth delegations are exchanged between various countries, to promote mutual understanding of values and culture among the youth and to develop better relations. This year, a 100-member youth delegation will visit China from 4th -11th November, 2014.

2. You are, therefore, requested to forward at least 20 nominations of Students (10 males and 10 females) from various NITs under your control. **The age of nominated delegates should not be more than 29 years.** The nominations must be submitted in the enclosed PROFORMA **within 10th October, 2014,** duly filled in by each participant with a recent coloured passport size photograph. No application will be considered if it is received after 15th October, 2014 in the Ministry.

3. It is also requested that once the nominated person is selected, he/she may be informed to bring one or two woollen clothes. Since pure vegetarian food is hardly available in China, nominated persons may also bring along ready to eat items for their own consumption. Forwarding of nominations do not entail selection. The Ministry holds sole discretion in the selection of candidates/ delegates and no communication will be entertained.
